

# 2017-18 Senior Picture Specifications

## Option 1: Preferred Photographer

This is the easiest and best option for a high quality senior portrait.

On the back of this sheet is a list of the EHS preferred (amazing) photographers. Links to their sites can also be found at [www.ehswings.org](http://www.ehswings.org). They have been provided with the specifications for senior photos and will format the photo you select to have featured in the yearbook.

Remember, for this option, the earlier you schedule, the better. Photographers' schedules fill up quickly during the summer—especially photographers like those on this list.

## Option 2: Take your own photo

If you have a friend or a family member who can take a high-quality portrait (without using a cell phone), you are free to use this option.

Here is what you need to know for that:

- **Submit digital file to Jostens School site on or before Monday, October 2.**

- Digital files need to be edited using photo software and saved at a resolution of 300 (used for print) resolution
- Must be saved as a .JPG file
- Only one file should be submitted (if more than one is submitted, we will use our discretion as to which to use)
- Photo size needs to be 2 1/4" by 3 1/4" (vertically oriented)
- Background should be uncluttered and free of distraction
- Pose is standing or sitting, head and torso only in the picture

## Option 3: Senior Portrait Sitting at Eaglecrest

On Saturday, Sept. 30, a former yearbook photographer will be available for a brief senior portrait sitting. You may sign up and pay for this option online once school begins. The cost will be \$20 and you will receive the digital copies of the photos for your own use.

## Clothing/Image Requirements for Submitted Photos:

- No hats, props, sunglasses, or pets
- No logos (unless Eaglecrest)
- Soft focus is not recommended
- No spaghetti straps, tube tops, or halter tops
- No hands and/or arms near or touching the face
- Solid colors look best
- V-Neck shirts are great options for girls, but make sure they aren't too deep
- White clothes often will wash out the picture
- Must adhere to school dress code

## Other things to remember:

### 1) Portrait Submission

- All photos taken by preferred photographers will be submitted by those photographers
- **All senior photos must be submitted on or before Monday, October 2**
- The yearbook staff will be contacting all seniors on or before the College Readiness Day to confirm the status of submission or missing photos.
- Students not using a preferred photographer must have a digital (accessible online through email, dropbox, cloud, etc.) file saved in the following format:  
**lastname\_firstname.jpg**

- There will be no handling fee for portraits submitted digitally
- **Senior photos may be submitted after July 1 by going to <https://images.jostens.com/408503610>**
- There will be a link to the Senior Photo Submission on the school website as well, beginning August 28, 2017

2) **Photos must be submitted by Monday, Oct. 2, or else they will not be included in the yearbook.** We have to work on deadlines dictated by an outside company to ensure the completion of the book, so please understand the strict deadline we provide.

3) Pictures not adhering to student dress code will be returned and not included in the yearbook. Please make sure that you have at least one photo with appropriate attire.
