2018-19 Senior Picture Specifications

Option 1: Preferred Photographer

This is the easiest and best option for a high quality senior portrait.

On the back of this sheet is a list of the EHS preferred (amazing) photographers. Links to their sites can also be found at www.ehswings.org. They have been provided with the specifications for senior photos and will format the photo you select to have featured in the yearbook.

Remember, for this option, the earlier you schedule, the better. Photographers' schedules fill up quickly during the summer—especially photographers like those on this list.

Option 2: Take your own photo

If you have a friend or a family member who can take a high-quality portrait (without using a cell phone), you may use this option.

Here is what you need to know for that:

- **Submit digital file to Jostens School site on or before Monday, October 1.**
- Digital files need to be edited using photo software and saved at a resolution of 300 (used for print)
- Must be saved as a .JPG file
- Only one file should be submitted (if more than one is submitted, we will use our discretion as to which to use)
- Photo size needs to be 2 1/4" by 3 1/4" (vertically oriented)
- Background should be uncluttered and free of distraction
- Pose is standing or sitting, head and upper torso only in the picture

Option 3: Senior Portrait Sitting at Eaglecrest

On Saturday, Sept. 15 and Saturday, Sept. 22, former yearbook photographers will be available for a brief senior portrait sitting. You may sign up for this option online once school begins. The cost will be \$20, and you can pay at the time of your portrait sitting. You will receive the digital copies of the photos for your own use either at the portrait sitting or the following Monday.

Seniors selecting this option must sign up for a 20-minute time slot. Pictures will be taken at 17 Mile Farmhouse Park off Parker Road (south of Cornerstar shops on the west side of Parker Rd.).

You will be able to select the photo for submission once you receive the photographs and submit them through the Jostens address provided on this information sheet.

Other things to remember:

1) Portrait Submission

- All photos taken by preferred photographers will be submitted by those photographers
- **All senior photos must be submitted on or before Monday, October 1**
- The yearbook staff will be posting names of submitted photos to confirm the submission by Friday, October 5.
- Students not using a preferred photographer must have a digital (accessible online through email, dropbox, cloud, etc.) **file saved in the following format:**
lastname_firstname.jpg

- There will be no handling fee for portraits submitted digitally
- **Senior photos may be submitted after July 1 by going <https://images.jostens.com/410353694>**
- There will be a link to the Senior Photo Submission on the school website as well, beginning August 1, 2018

2) **Photos must be submitted by Monday, Oct. 1, or else they will not be included in the yearbook.** We have to work on deadlines dictated by an outside company to ensure the completion of the book, so please understand the strict deadline we provide.

3) Pictures not adhering to student dress code will be returned and not included in the yearbook. We will notify students of this situation and provide a week to resubmit. If students do not resubmit, we will replace it with the school photo from Registration. Please make sure that you have at least one photo with appropriate attire, no props, and hands free from the face/head portion of the photo.

Clothing/Image Requirements for Submitted Photos:

- Solid colors look best
- White clothes often will wash out the picture
- No logos (unless Eaglecrest)
- No hands and/or arms near or touching the face
- Soft focus is not recommended
- Must adhere to school dress code
 - No hats, props, sunglasses, or pets
 - No tube tops
 - No clothing with references to illegal substances
